## About the project

INTER-ACT project aims to equip Primary Education Teachers with Inclusion Guidelines and an Interactive Learning Tool in order to enhance the inclusion of refugee and immigrant students in EU classrooms.

The project includes the development of the INTER-ACT Book which will take all students in a classroom through a narrative story and its pages will include puzzles and activities that will challenge students to work together in order to solve them and achieve goals. Through this activity, students will develop their interpersonal skills, they will learn about each other and how to work together, exchange cultural experiences and at the same time, will learn about Europe and European Values.

*The meeting was a complete success and the following objectives were set.*

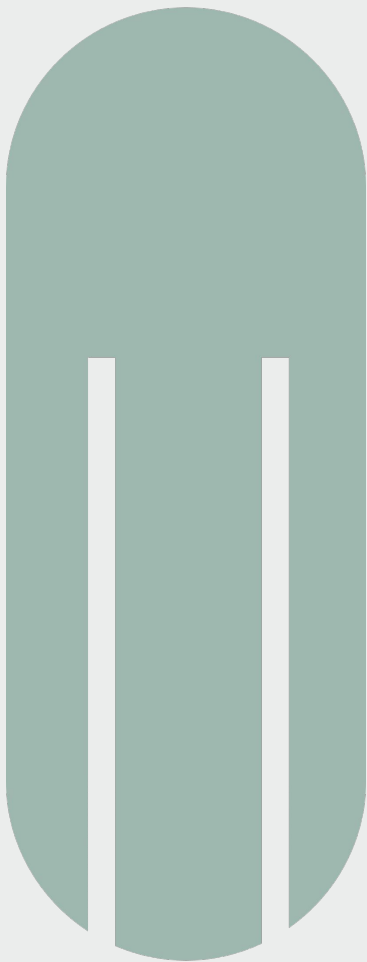
During the 2nd semester of the INTER-ACT project, activities revolved around the development of the chapters of INTER-ACT Book.
